

Rules and Regulations

- 1. Age of cattle is determined from 1 October 2021
- 2. Exhibitors/Owners must appoint competent and responsible handlers at all times
- All attendants, handlers and exhibitors must obey the orders of stewards. Not compliance may result in removal from the showground
- 4. Exhibitors/Owners must have current Public Liability insurance, minimum \$10 million covering the 2022 Mullumbimby Show period. Certificate of Currency must accompany entry form.
- 5. All stud stock must be either registered or eligible to be registered with their respective Breed Societies & have registered name on entry form.
- 6. Cows in stud beef classes 3 years & over must be in calf or show signs of having been a breeder
- 7. Bulls over 12 months must have a nose ring which is to be used at all times
- 8. Bulls over 6 months must be penned or tied up immediately upon entering the showground.
- All entries must be received by 5pm on 5th November 2022 no entries will be accepted on the day
- 10. Only 1st prize animals can compete for Champion. Animals over the age of 20 months can compete for Senior Champion. Animals placed 2nd in a class of the animal placed Champion can compete for award or Reserve Champion
- 11. If a doubt arises in the mind of the judge or judges in any class as to classification of a competing animal, the matter will be referred to the Chief Steward for consideration.
- 12. In all classes judges will award 2nd and 3rd places.
- 13. There must be minimum of 2 exhibits in classes except aged bulls or 1st prize will be awarded except in classes where the judge recognizes an exhibit to be of high merit and recommends a prize.
- 14. All exhibits to be bona-fide property of owner except where otherwise stated. All exhibits from a partnership or company must be bona-fide property of the firm exhibiting same and no animal owned by an individual member of the firm will be eligible for a prize unless exhibited in his own name.
- 15. All calves paraded with their mother will be eligible for registration if they are not more than 8 months of age as at 1 October 2022 and if paraded with cow they cannot be shown in single classes.
- 16. Admission to the grounds will be charged to all non-members of the Society
- 17. All exhibits are to be on the grounds by 8.00am.
- 18. All exhibitors must have read and agreed to abide by the conditions as set down by the Society.
- 19. All exhibitors must have return NATIONAL CATTLE HEALTH STATEMENT form and all other relevant waivers download from website www.mullumbimbyshow.org.au
- 20. All exhibits must be NLIS device tagged.
- 21. All exhibitors and are supply own hay, straw for animal bedding.

Bayer Animal Health High Achiever Award

"Growing the potential of the Far North Coast"

The Bayer Animal Health High Point Achiever Award is designed to encourage and reward seed stock beef producers for participating and supporting Group One Agricultural Shows throughout the year. Eligible Shows include: Bonalbo, Woodenbong, Grafton, Maclean, Nimbin, Kyogle, Casino, Lismore, Alstonville, Murwillumbah, Mullumbimby and Bangalow. The award will be announced after Bangalow Show in 2022.

The winner of the Bayer Animal Health High Achiever Award receives \$1,000, runner up receives \$500 and third place will receive \$250.

This competition is open only to exhibitors who enter beef cattle under the same Exhibitor Name throughout the competition year. No Group class points will be included. The Bayer Animal Health High Point Achiever Award will be judged based on the following points:

NOTE: Points are cumulative, i.e. the winner of a Class, Champion and Grand Champion would obtain 11 points (3+3+5).

Section A - Supplier's statements about risk and duty of care

The handling of animals is a dangerous recreational activity as animals can act in a sudden and unpredictable way, especially when frightened or hurt.

Participation (including passive participation) in animal handling and/or physical competitions and/or Events at an agricultural show and/or use of the Suppliers' facilities contain elements of risk, both obvious and inherent.

Physical competitions and activities, Events and use of the Suppliers' facilities are all dangerous recreational activities. This document is a risk warning for the purpose of section 5M of the Civil Liability Act NSW 2002. This risk warning is given by or on behalf of the Suppliers.

This document acts as an exclusion of liability under Part 1A Division 5 of the Civil Liability Act NSW 2002 if the services supplied by the Suppliers are supplied without reasonable care and skill.

<u>Section B - Participant's acknowledgements</u>

By signing this document I acknowledge that:

- Participation in the Event and/or use of the Suppliers' facilities is a recreational service for the purposes of section 139A of the Australian Competition and Consumer Act (Cth) 2010 and a recreational activity for the purposes of section 5K of the Civil Liability Act (NSW) 2002.
- 2. I participate in the Event and/or use of the Suppliers' facilities at my own risk.
- 3. Participation in the Event and/or use of the Suppliers' facilities is a hazardous activity and involves a significant risk of physical harm and may result in injury, loss, damage or death to me and others.

- 9. In handling animals, there is a risk of suffering injury including injuries caused by the animals.
- 10. I am responsible for ensuring that I have and will wear equipment suitable for my safety in my participation of the Event and/or in using the Suppliers' facilities.
- 11. I am responsible for the condition of any tools and equipment and ensuring that they are appropriate for the Event and/or in using the Suppliers' facilities.
- 12. I use the Suppliers' facilities, including for the Event entirely at my own risk, as I find them and with the prior



- acceptance of the risk of possible danger to me, both obvious and inherent.
