Rules and Regulations

- 1. Age of cattle is determined from 1st October 2022.
- 2. Exhibitors/Owners must appoint competent and reliable handlers at all times.
- 3. All attendants, handlers and exhibitors must obey the orders of Stewards. Non compliance may result in removal from the Showground.
- 4. Exhibitors/Owners must have current Public Liability insurance, min \$10 million covering the 2023 Mullumbimby Show period. Certificate of Currency must accompany entry form.
- 5. All stud stock must either be registered or eligible to be registered with their respective Breed Societies & have registered name of entry form.
- 6. Cows in stud breed classes 3 years & over must be in calf or show signs of having been a breeder.
- 7. Bulls over 12 months old must have a nose ring which is to be used at all times.
- 8. Bulls over 6 months must be penned or tied up immediately upon entering the showgound.
- 9. All entries must be received by 5.00pm on the 4th November 2023 no entries will be accepted after this time or on the day.
- 10. Only 1st prize animals can compete for Champion. Animals over 20 months can compete for Senior Champion.
- 11. If doubt arises in the mind of the Judge or Judges in any class as to classification of a competing animal, the matter will be referred to the Chief Steward for consideration.
- 12. There must be a minimum of 2 exhibits in classes except aged bulls, or 1st prize will not be award except in classes where the Judge recognizes an exhibit to be of high merit and recommends a prize.
- 13. All exhibits to be bona-fide property of owner except where otherwise stated. All exhibits from partnership pr company must be bona-fide property of the firm exhibiting same and no animal owned by an individual member of a firm will be eligible for a prize unless exhibited in his own name
- 14. All calves paraded with their mother must be eligible for registration if they are not more than 8 months of age as at 1st October 2023 and if paraded with cow, they cannot be shown in single classes.
- 15. Admission to the ground will be charged to all non-members of the Society.
- 16. All exhibitors are to be on the showground by 8.00am.
- 17. All exhibitors must have read and agreed to abide by the conditions as set down by the Society.
- 18. All exhibitors must have return NATIONAL CATTLE HEALTH STATEMENT form and all other relevant waivers down-load from website www.mullumbimbyshow.org.au
- 19. All exhibits must be NLIS device tagged.
- 20. All exhibitors are to supply their own hay, straw for animal bedding.
- 21. All exhibitor coming from Queensland, must adhere to DPI requirements for movement of hay coming to New South Wales. A "Plant Health Certificate" will be required to enter Showgrounds. The Bayer Animal Health High Point Achiever Award is designed to encourage and reward seed stock beef producers for participating and supporting Group One Agricultural Shows throughout the year. Eligible Shows include: Bonalbo, Woodenbong, Grafton, Maclean, Nimbin, Kyogle, Casino, Lismore, Alstonville, Murwillumbah, Mullumbimby and Bangalow. The award will be announced after Bangalow Show in 2023.

The winner of the Bayer Animal Health High Achiever Award receives \$1,000, runner up receives \$500 and third place will receive \$250.

This competition is open only to exhibitors who enter beef cattle under the same Exhibitor Name throughout the competition year. No Group class points will be included. The Bayer Animal Health High Point Achiever Award will be judged based on the following points:
